All applications to the Junior Infants in Faughart Community National School will only be accepted from Friday 10th October 2025 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the Friday 7th November 2025. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class in Faughart Community National School will only be accepted from Monday 1st June 2026 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the Monday 22nd June 2026. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Equally, any transfer applications received during the current academic year, i.e. before June 2026, to transfer into a class immediately, will be treated as a late application where the application window for transferring into the school for the academic year 2025/2026 took place during the previous academic year and anyone who did not receive a place at that time was put on a waiting list. Therefore, any available places that arise in that class during the 2025/2026 academic year will be filled from that waiting list, until that list expires at the end of the academic year 2025/2026.

All applicants to the Junior Infants will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	Friday 28th November 2025
Successful applicants to the Junior Infants Group must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission Faughart Community National School by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	Friday 12th December 2025
All transfer applications to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class other than to the Special Class, for the following academic year will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	Monday 13th July 2026
Successful transfer applicants to Senior Infants, First Class, Second Class, Third Class, Fourth Class, Fifth Class or Sixth Class other than to the Special Class, in the following academic year must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Faughart CNS by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	Monday 27th July 2026
Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above may result in the offer being withdrawn.	

Faughart CNS will cooperate with the National Council for Special Education in the performance by the Council of its functions under the Education for Persons with Special Educational Needs Act 2004 relating to the provision of education to children with special educational needs, including in particular by the provision and operation of a special class or classes when requested to do so by the Council.
